


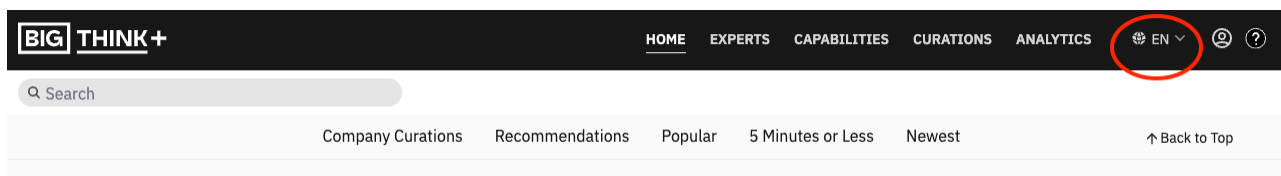
# How do I change my language and video caption preferences?

*This article outlines how to set your preferred platform language and video captions for your Big Think+ account.*

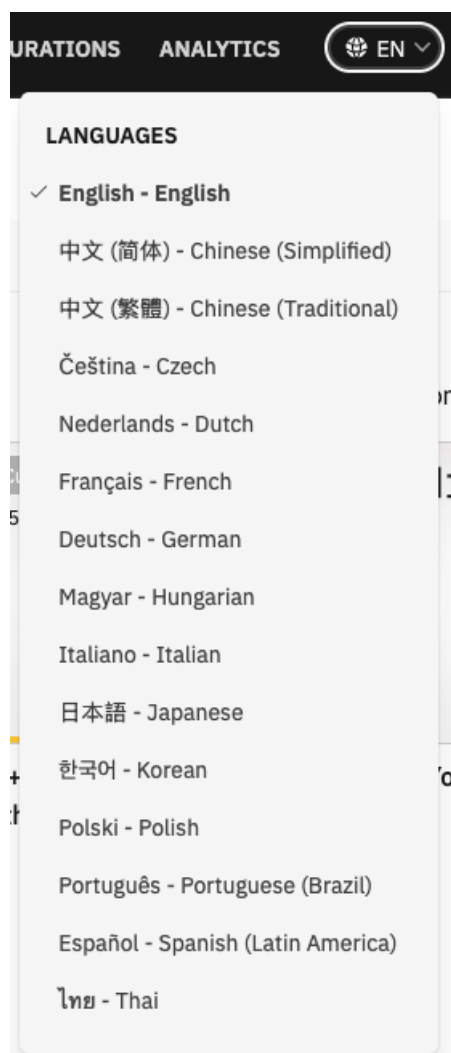
## 1. Locate the Language Menu

- Go to the **top right corner** of any Big Think+ page.
- You'll see a **globe icon**  next to a two-letter label that indicates your current language (e.g., "EN" for English).



## 2. Open the Language Menu

- Click the language button to open a drop-down menu labeled **"Languages."**
- This menu shows all available **full platform translations**.
- Selecting a language here will:
  - Translate the entire platform interface.
  - Set your **default captions language** for videos.



### 3. Choose Your Platform Language

- Click on the language you want.
- The platform will automatically reload in your selected language.
- Any Learner Guides and Discussion Guides will also be downloaded in your chosen language.

### 4. Adjust Video Captions Separately (Optional)

- While watching a video, click the **settings gear** ⚙️ in the video player.
- Under “**Captions**”, you can choose from **all 25 available languages** — even those not included in the platform-wide language list.
- If you change captions here, it will **override** the captions language set in the main language menu.
- **Note:** This change affects **captions only**; the platform language will not update.
