
This article explains how to use the content-level views in Big Think+ Analytics to track engagement with curations, lessons, learning paths, expert classes, and courses.

Big Think+ Analytics offers multiple tabs where you can view performance data by content type. Each tab includes key engagement metrics, sortable tables, and downloadable data. You can use these views to identify what content is resonating most with your team.

Where can I see analytics by content type?

At the top of the Analytics page, you'll find tabs for the following content types:

Curations | Lessons | Learning Paths & Classes | Courses



Each view includes consistent metrics that help you compare performance across formats.

What data is available in each content view?

All data reflects activity within the [date range](#) selected at the top of the Analytics dashboard.
